

## WHAT TO BRING TO BRIERCREST

This is a list of suggested items to bring to dorm. It is not to be used as a final packing list—you may need more than is listed here.

### FOR YOUR ROOM

### BATHROOM

Soap

Shampoo/conditioner  
 Deodorant  
 Towels  
 Toothbrush/paste  
 Other personal items  
 Laundry soap  
 Needle and thread

### SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Computer (optional)  
 Binders  
 Loose leaf, printer paper  
 Pens/pencils  
 Calculator (optional)  
 Folders/duo-tangs  
 Stapler/staples  
 \*Your professors will tell you what you need for classes.

### CLOTHING

Everyday/casual wear  
 Formal dress (for special occasions)  
 Gym clothes (cannot be worn in class)

Please note that Saskatchewan winters can get as cold as -45° Celsius. Pack accordingly with:  
 Winter coat  
 Boots  
 Toque and gloves  
 Sweaters, extra layers  
 Extra blankets

## WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Due to space limitations in our dorm residence rooms, computer monitors/TVs must not exceed a maximum screen size of 32 inches.
- Please leave any media (music/DVDs, etc.) that may be unwholesome at home.
- Be aware that there is no bike storage allowed inside of the dorms. If you have an expensive bike that you do not want to store outdoors in a bike rack, it would be better for you to leave it at home.
- Pets are not allowed in residence rooms.
- Be aware that this will be your home, but that this new home has limited space available. Please avoid over-packing!

**Note:** There is an option to send some of your belongings out ahead of time to make moving easier.
